What should I do to get baptised at Lower Mountains Anglican?

1. Join one of our [congregations](#).
2. Speak to one of the Ministry Team members about your interest in baptism.
3. Fill out an 'Application for Baptism' – [Infant Baptism \(pdf\)](#), [Adult Baptism \(pdf\)](#), [Confirmation \(pdf\)](#).
4. To prepare, expect to meet with a Minister on at least four occasions before the baptism. This will include a short course called JesusWORKS. This will also be a time to ensure that you know what is being asked and promised in the baptism service (we don't want you to be caught off guard!)
5. Get baptised!
